This Indenture made in & entered into this Sixteenth day of May 1837 between William Mallary and Catharine his wife of the County of Simpson of the one part and Levi Moore of the County of Logan of the other part and both parties of the State of Kentucky witness that the said William Mallary for and in consideration of the Sum of Five Hundred and Seventy Five Dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell ? and convey unto the said Levi Moore all that tract or parcel

of Land Lying and being in Logan County and State of Kentucky near Huffmans Mill and Bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a Small Hickory and Stake North east corner to a two hundred acre tract of Land conveyed by William Stewart to George Mason running with Masons east Boundary line S10E170 poles to the north Boundary line of Two hundred acre Surveyed formerly occupied by Bradley and at this time by Burn thence with that line S80E70 poles to a Black Jack and Hickory north east corner to the same thence bounding on the Line of a 150 acre Tract of Land sold by William Stewart to Ann Angel to the Line of Philip Caldwells 400 acre survey thence with that line S80W120 poles to a black Jack Southeast corner to William Angel thence continuing the same course of S80W to the Beginning with all its appurtenances as thereunto belonging to have and to hold the above said Land and premises unto the said Levi Moore his heirs +c forever and the said William Mallary and his wife Catharine will warrant and forever defend the same from themselves their heirs and assigns and from all persons claiming by and through them or in any other manner whatever in testimony where of the said William Mallary and Catharine have herein to set their hands and seals the date first above written.
